

2021 CAMP DATES: MONDAY, JUNE 28TH THROUGH THURSDAY, AUGUST 19TH

WELCOME TO NABBY!

We wanted to share the following helpful information to make your summer at Nabby the very best it can be. Please note our updated COVID-19 protocols, following the recommendations of the [American Camp Association](#) (ACA), [Centers for Disease Control](#) (CDC) and the [NY State Health Department](#).



MASK POLICY

Following NY State Department of Health guidelines, mask wearing at camp for children outdoors and within their stable group is not required.

Children not yet in Kindergarten, do not need to wear face coverings while on camp property.

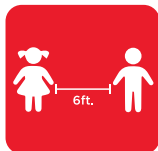
With almost all of our activities outdoors, we don't expect your children to be wearing face masks for any significant part of the day. Please have your children bring their own clearly labeled masks to camp every day so they are prepared in select situations.

Current Kindergartners and above are encouraged to wear face coverings, when feasible in the following situations:

- On all Nabby buses
- Indoors at Arts & Crafts
- When social distancing between stable groups outdoors cannot be met (i.e. during morning assembly and special entertainment performances)

Children not yet in Kindergarten do not need to wear face coverings while on camp property but should plan to wear on all Nabby buses.

We are happy to share that our entire staff (age 16 and older) will be fully vaccinated this summer. Vaccinated staff are not required to wear masks at camp but will model mask-wearing for our campers when indoors and on the bus.



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

We are fortunate to have 17 beautiful acres of camp grounds to explore that will allow our campers to enjoy almost all activities outside and have the space to do so. Within each stable group, physical distancing will be not required, but within indoor camp buildings (bathrooms, dining room, camp office) and larger activities outside each mini-group, physical distancing of 6 ft will be maintained.



HEALTH FORMS & SCREENINGS

Due to Department of Health guidelines, it is imperative we receive all completed health forms prior to the start of camp. These forms now include updated immunization records.

We will implement health screening and temperature checks for all staff and any visitors (vendors) each day at camp. We are asking for your assistance in doing the same with your children each day before they leave for Nabby. You will be invited to download the **FEVER FREE** App by the middle of June and provide daily health updates so we can monitor our community.

We also ask that anyone (staff, children) who is feeling sick, please stay home and not come to camp. All absences should be reported to the camp office by 9 am so we can plan for the group activities accordingly.



SANITIZATION & HAND WASHING

We take great pride in the cleanliness of our facilities and will implement additional precautions this summer. Nabby will use all CDC and Department of Health recommended sanitation products and will clean all equipment and frequently touched/shared surfaces throughout the day.

Per CDC Guidelines, we will have campers and staff wash hands throughout the day, upon arrival, before and after meals, after using the restroom and after all activities. Camp will feature additional hand wash facilities and will have hand sanitizer stations located throughout the property.





STABLE GROUP/“PODS”

Each camp group will have their own bunk and dedicated counselors - and are considered “stable” groups/pods. These are the groups that children and staff will spend the majority of their day with, and just like your own family members, no social distancing will be required while in their pod.



ACTIVITIES

We are fortunate to have almost all outdoor facilities and with our stable groups, we expect all camp activities to run as planned.

Within the pool for free swim, we will have “lanes” dedicated for our stable groups and instruction swim will take place in small groups with dedicated instructors in and outside the pool, as in previous years.



WHAT TO BRING EACH DAY

(A reminder to be sure to clearly label all personal items)

- Two Bathing Suits
- Two Towels
- A bag lunch (Monday through Friday if not purchasing hot lunch program)
- A face mask/covering
- Optional: Pool shoes, Goggles, Sunscreen, Water Bottle

WHAT TO WEAR

Comfortable, athletic clothing is strongly encouraged, including shorts and t-shirts (all clearly labeled with your child’s name). Sneakers are also strongly recommended (no sandals/thongs/crocs).

On cooler, rainy days, feel free to include a rain jacket or sweatshirt in your child’s bag.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT

- Senior campers will need a tennis racquet and baseball glove
- Junior campers can bring baseball gloves if they have, or we can provide



LUNCH & SNACK

Lunch protocols will eliminate self serving and any shared foods. Daily snacks are provided by camp and include seasonal fruit, vegetables, cheese & crackers and plenty of water!

In addition to our new hot lunch program (Monday through Wednesday - available for an additional fee) Nabby provides two hot meals each week for every camper: Barbeques on Thursday and Pizza on Friday. Nabby BBQ’s feature all beef hamburgers (fresh from Hemlock Hills Farm) or veggie burgers, Kosher all-beef hot dogs or turkey dogs (based on request). Pizza lunch every Friday features traditional pies from two local Pizzerias. All food will be served in individual portions with no sharing.

If not participating in the hot lunch offering, campers should plan to bring their own bag lunches Monday through Wednesday. Each lunch bag will be refrigerated in each camper’s bunk upon arrival at camp.

Milk and water are provided for every lunch and microwaves are available in our dining room to reheat food. Personal water bottles are encouraged (please be sure to put your name on it!)

FOOD ALLERGIES

Camp Nabby does not serve nut products. Our staff is made aware of all food & nut allergies and will keep children with allergies away from children with nut products in their personal lunches. Parents serving peanut or tree nut products are asked to clearly label the bag with “**PEANUT**” or “**NUTS**” and those children will be required to wash their hands after eating.



FREE CAMP GEAR: BACKPACKS, TOWELS AND T-SHIRTS

Parents are invited to pick up a Nabby backpack, towel and t-shirt for their camper(s) any weekend (except Saturday June 12) through the start of camp between 10 am and 2 pm or during the week by appointment.



PARENT PICK-UP & DROP-OFF PROCEDURE

PRE-K DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP:

Pre-K campers should be dropped off at the Front Gate of camp (Tamarac Street & Nabby Hill) between 8:40 and 9 am. We ask that you stay in your seat and allow our staff to help the children in and out of the car.

Pre-K pick up is at 3:45 pm in front of the white house at 1 Nabby Hill. Pre-K parents should display their **GREEN** windshield card for identification.

JUNIOR CAMP DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP:

Junior Campers (K through 3rd Grade) should be dropped off at the Front Gate of camp (Tamarac Street & Nabby Hill) between 8:40 and 9 am. We ask that you stay in your seat and allow our staff to help the children in and out of the car.

Pick-up starts at 3:50 pm at the front gate and all cars should line up along the green fence on Tamarac Street. Junior Campers with senior camp siblings will dismiss at 4:05 pm with the rest of the senior campers. Junior Camp parents should display their **YELLOW** windshield card for identification.

SENIOR CAMP DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP:

Senior Campers (4th - 8th Grade) with Junior Camp siblings should be dropped off and picked up at the Front Gate of camp (Tamarac Street & Nabby Hill) between 8:40 and 9 am.

Parents should arrive no earlier than 4:05 pm and should display their **RED** windshield card for identification.

All other Senior Campers (with no Junior Camp siblings) should be dropped off and picked up at our camp back entrance at the Dale Street parking lot on Dale Street.

Afternoon pick-up for these Senior Campers is 4:05 pm (to allow for bus dismissal).

Please note: To minimize wait time, we strongly encourage all parents to adhere to the times listed above and avoid the urge to arrive early. Senior Camp parents should not arrive before 4 pm so the junior campers can dismiss and allow for a smooth, orderly and SAFE exit for everyone. We appreciate your cooperation!

RAINY DAYS

We are fortunate to have many covered facilities at camp and can enjoy a full schedule of activities on rainy days. Our special "rainy day" schedules are designed to keep our campers organized and active!

DOOR-TO-DOOR AND SATELLITE BUS SERVICE

All campers choosing door-to-door or satellite bus service will receive contact information for their bus monitors in the days prior to their start date and pick up/drop off times prior to camp opening.

LATE ARRIVAL & EARLY DEPARTURES

Children can be dismissed early from camp if we have written permission from a parent (email or note) or a phone call. Early dismissal must be before 3:30 pm and we will bring your child to the front gate for sign out. Due to safety protocols, parents will not be permitted in the camp office. We will bring your child directly to you!
