Dear Nabby Family,



A MEMORABLE SUMMER AS A NABBY PARENT AND COUNSELOR

We are fortunate to have an extraordinary staff, highlighted by many teachers and adult counselors who choose to spend their summers at Nabby along with their children, who are campers. Alex and his boys Brandon and Hudson joined us this summer and wrote a beautiful tribute to Nabby that we wanted to share with all of you!

When looking for a summer program for my children, I found Camp Nabby on a Google search and scheduled a tour with Rita. I remember thinking the camp was immaculate, but most of the rest of the tour was a blur with one exception at the very end. Rita explained that almost all the staff either had been campers at Nabby, or their kids either were attending or had attended Nabby. As an economist, the appeal of aligned incentives between the staff and the experience of the kids spoke to me because one would expect those employees there to do a great job and keep the kids safe. Unbeknownst to me, I also earned myself a subsequent job offer from Rita and Joe.

Sending my kids to Nabby and working here last summer as a substitute counselor and "iack of all trades" was not a good decision... it was a great decision. I honestly have perspective too because you never really know what you have until you lose it. Halfway through the summer, I sprained my ankle and wound up on crutches. Suddenly teaching our campers how to play sports, helping them improve their swimming, playing games, and making sure every single camper had the best time every

My son Brandon was not a good swimmer when he arrived at Nabby, but by the end of the summer, earned his green band (allowing him to swim in the middle pool and shallow end of the big pool) after working with Junior Camp Swim Instructor, Maddie.

The Bertino family loves all the kids and staff. And as for me, I have a busy professional life and don't need to work as a counselor at Nabby, but I will do this for as long as I can because it is a magical place for the campers to have positive growth experiences and because of how hard the caring staff works.
